Today, we retrograded the rubbish to Concordia and transferred the PB300 with the crane for repair. We continued setting up the PICARRO but realized the autosampler software was not installed and switched to the alternative PICARRO. As we had the impression the first drill electronics had leaked in liquid, we decided to test the second electronics. The mounting took till noon as we had to overwork the plugs and the mechanical connections. We had to abort the first descent of the drill, as the electronics did not respond. After pulling the drill to the surface, it responded and we could do one full run without any problems. It could well be that the electronics were still too cold during the first descent. We are hopeful that the electronics will work normally and check this tomorrow. This remained the only run, as our Saturday night break started after. The processing trench processed thirteen meters today. Just before dinner Michele and Danilo returned from Concordia, we happily stored away the supplies and had a nice dinner and enjoyable evening together.
