## Situation Report #37, 23<sup>th</sup> December 2025

**Weather at LDC:** some clouds in the morning, slight wind and cold

**Meteo at DC 6:15 pm:** T = -18.0 °C, Wind speed = 5.6 kt, Windchill T = -25 °C, Humidity = 78%



Yesterday evening, we had the third camera run. During previous tests on the surface at -30 °C, the camera ran for over 3 hours. Unfortunately, down in the drill liquid at around -50° it stopped recording after 35 minutes. The lights ran the whole time. Back at the surface and after warming up for ca. 30 minutes, the batteries were still full, and the camera could proceed recording.

In the morning, we could see the video of the installation, the start of the run and the camera's way down the hole. The transparent cylinder improved the picture, but the liquid was still too slushy to see details from the wall of the hole. At a quarter past 10 pm and 1271 m depth the camera stopped recording, which is way above our point of interest at around 2350 m depth.

Today, we dismantled the outer shaft, the motor section and the dead weight from the antitorque and mounted the Danish mini-logger, after Matthias supplied it with fresh batteries and switched it on. The run takes over 10 hours...

Besides the routine business on the logistic side (emptying the waste water tank, grooming the camp area, refilling the fuel tanks of the tents), Sergio improved the road to Concordia for a couple of kilometres.

Meanwhile, Christmas preparations are speeding up in the kitchen and the drillers' cabin...
