# **EGRIP** camp activities:

Monday was the last day of drilling and processing of 2018. Since then, camp personnel has been busy packing, documenting, doing inventory and taking down small tents and two weatherports. On Thursday, camp received a plane with a last group exchange people. The Skiway had been groomed after significant fresh snowfall and flight operations ran smoothly. Skiway was so good that Skier 91 (with new propellers) was able to take off at -3 C with a 19,100 lbs payload using 2/3 skiway. The ceiling of the snow caves is now being trimmed above any structure so that 30 cm free space is obtained. Preparations for installing new kitchen equipment in main dome.

## **Drilling:**

Drilling continued to Monday 02:00 where the last core of 2018 was drilled (a final drillers's depth of 1754m in 2018), then some filter runs were performed. The final cores were logged from 1757.44 m to 1767.57 m (final depth for 2018). Drilling operations have ended for 2018.

#### Science:

Processing from 1714.35 m to 1765.10 m (bag 3199 final bag for 2018).

Isotope laboratory closed down for 2018 (bag 2560 final bag for 2018).

Physical properties lab closed down for 2018 (bag 3117 last bag for 2018). Packing of PP lab.

Monday was the last day of sampling in the surface program and also the day of the last vapor drone flight.

All camp personnel participated in winterizing and packing down in camp.

The deep borehole was logged Tuesday.

At the end of the week, the first tests of the Alabama radar began.

## Weather at EGRIP:

Monday morning fog and fine, Tuesday and Wednesday, warm, partly thin overcast. Thursday and Friday, warm, overcast, clearing in evening, On Wednesday another warm day with -0.5 C. Temperatures were between -22 C and - 0.5 C and the wind was between 4 and 14 knots most days from 220-270T.

## **Kangerlussuaq activities:**

Picked up food and spareparts from Air freight and sleds and spareparts from Royal Arctic Line. Received 7 people in Kangerlussuaq, packed 3 pallets of cargo, received 27 people from the field and three pallets of ice and equipment. Ice is now in freezer in Kangerlussuaq.

## Weather in Kangerlussuaq/SFJ:

Mostly fine with rain and low clouds in a few nights. Temperatures between 6 and 23 degrees. Mosquito situation has improved, only a few remain.
