EGRIP camp activities:

The first full week at EGRIP is now over for the put-in team. Due to good weather conditions, we have accomplished a lot, while we attempt to catch up from the unfortunate delay of the put-in. All heavy machines are running. We have access to the garages, and they are free from snow on the roof and partly at the side. The entire skiway, lead-ins and apron have been surveyed and marked with a complete set of new markers and groomed several times. Five weatherports have been built. Most power outlets have been located and several cables in cable ducts have been pulled out in preparation to move the dome. The cover over the elevator shaft has been excavated which allowed for access to the trenches and a first peek into trenches was made. In the trenches, there will be a lot of snow to be removed from the ceiling etc., but at a first glance it appears that damage to the equipment is repairable. Excavation of the dome is in progress.

Drilling:

No drilling is scheduled before late June.

Science:

EGRIP Camp Population: 9.

Weather at EGRIP:

Temperatures between -23 to -40°C. Blue sky with winds at 2-6 m/s mainly from westerly directions.

Kangerlussuaq activities:

Monday we handed in the waste oil from camp from 2019 to Marktjenesten. Tuesday we exchanged the Field Operations Managers (FOMs). We said goodbye to Jesper and Marie and welcomed Sune. Most of the week has been used to sort out cargo and clean up in the warehouse, while making plans for the coming flight week. We received the final approvals for the airdrop planned for June. The drill fluid drums are outside the warehouse and ready to be bundled for the airdrop. We are preparing for the next mission to

EGRIP, including helping our associated projects with receiving their expedition permits. These permits have not yet been issued.

Weather in Kangerlussuaq/SFJ:

It is still winter in Kangerlussuaq and colder than usual at this time of the year. Three days with snow during the week. Otherwise mostly nice days with sun and temperatures between -2°C to -8°C, but pleasant in the sun. Mosquito situation: None.
