# **Drilling:**

As the deep drilling is terminated, the winch cable was cut, the drill, the tower, the inclined trench installations and two Viessmann cabins were removed from the trenches and the first two casing extensions have been mounted. The drill tower and most drill equipment were packed and shipped to SFJ during the week. The cryo-egg installations were also packed and shipped. In the white tent the installation of the new intermediate drill system continues.

#### Science:

Two ApRES stations were recovered, 9 out of 10 now recovered.
